Guidelines for applicants

With fresh content, state of the art approach, experienced mentors, engaging and stimulating presenters and a wonderful venue, the program provides the opportunity for you to:

- Capitalise on career opportunities

Applications should include the following:

1. A statement written by the applicant, detailing career aspirations, achievements & expectations if successful in this application
2. Resume
3. A recommendation from your supervisor.
4. A recommendation and statement of support from your employer indicating that they will cover the Institute cost.

Steps to registering your application.

1. Prepare your 4 documents as above.
2. Once these 4 documents have been completed, visit <http://aurorafoundation.org.au/leadership-institute/#registration> and fill out the appropriate fields
3. Upload each document individually then click SUBMIT.

Scholarships: Several scholarships are available and applicants should indicate in their written statement (document 1) if they wish to be considered for a scholarship and why they should be successful in obtaining a scholarship. Scholarships are awarded from the pool of successful applicants based on merit or financial need.

Institute Cost: \$4995 plus GST (no payment is required until applicant is advised of the success of their application). The cost covers course fees, accommodation, & all meals.
